Departure/ Arrival:

DEPARTURE TIME:

GCS: WE WILL BE LEAVING THE SCHOOL AT 5:45 AM on Saturday, May 23rd.

MEIJER, PIERSON RD.: WE NEED TO BE LOADED AND READY TO GO BY 6:30 AM.

It is very important that everyone arrives **on time** so that we can load and depart on schedule. Please do not change your pick up location without notifying Mr. Wright.

ARRIVAL TIME: We will be arriving back at GCS the Afternoon of Monday, May 25th about **3:30 PM @ Pierson Rd. & around 4:00PM @ the school.**

Things to bring:

LUGGAGE: Please limit your luggage to **one** small suitcase and a small bag.

DRESS CODE:

1. All clothing must be modest & decent. GCS school attire is always appropriate.
2. GCS Staff reserves the right to ask any person to change if the clothes being worn are immodest or suggestive. (Imprinted T-shirts that glorify the world are not to be worn—e.g., TV or movie stars, rock singers, country singer, etc.)
3. All pants must be neat, clean and not excessively baggy or sloppy. Pajama pants and sweat pants are not appropriate attire for this trip.

GUYS:

1. Jeans, casual pants, shorts to the knee, with a collared shirts or appropriate T-shirt or sweatshirt. No tanks tops.
2. Swimming: A T-shirt must be worn with a swimsuit while going to and from the pool.

GIRLS:

1. Jeans, casual pants, shorts to the knee, capris with a collared shirts or appropriate T-shirt or sweatshirt. No tanks tops.
2. A modest one-piece swimsuit must be worn under a dark T-shirt for all swimming activities. If there is an all-female swim, you will be allowed to wear your swimsuits without clothing over it.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

1. You may want to bring a sweatshirt, jacket, and an umbrella for cool or rainy weather.
2. A good pair of walking shoes is strongly advised.
3. Electronic devises such as Ipods, Mp3 players, ear buds for cell phones, and gaming devises are not permitted on the trip. If they are seen or heard, devises will be confiscated until we return.
4. Cell phones are allowed, but will be allowed to be used on a limited basis. GCS staff may confiscate cell phones at any time during the trip if they are not being used appropriately.
5. Restroom stops are few (one stop each way). Do not plan on drinking constantly while traveling.
6. Be respectful to each person's vehicle. Do not take messy foods or leave trash in the vehicles.
7. You will not be responsible for any meals—see itinerary. You may want extra money for snacks and other items.
8. The hotel rooms must be clean and things put away. Every room will be checked by the chaperon before leaving the hotel.
9. When checking out of the hotel on Monday, please do not turn in your room keys to the front desk. Keys are to be given back Mr. Wright.
10. If there is anything wrong with your room or you need extra towels, let Mr. Wright know immediately.
11. Proper conduct and respect is expected at all times. GCS reverses the right to send serious offenders home at their parents' expense.
12. Unless your parent is coming with you, the room chaperon must handle all medications.
13. Students may not be by themselves or only with the opposite gender. Your adult chaperon must know your whereabouts at all times.
14. The adult in your room is considered your chaperone. This adult maybe different than who you are riding with. Your room adult should know your whereabouts at all times. (See Room & Riding lists)
