According to the State of Michigan **all transfer, K-4, Kindergarten and 7th grade students** will need to have all their vaccinations up-to-date or a certified State of Michigan Immunization Waiver Form from the county health department. If you choose not to receive some (or all) of your child's vaccinations then you will need to obtain a certified State of Michigan Immunization Waiver Form from your county health department. You may do this during the summer. Vaccinations for the above groups are reported to the MI Health Department at the beginning of each year.
