GCS Parents,

A student in the GCS junior class was exposed to COVID-19. When the student became aware of this exposure, they were tested and received notice of a positive test result. We received notice over the weekend of this result and began contact tracing to determine close contact, according to CDC guidelines, and quarantine for some students and staff. If your child is considered to be a close contact, GCS administration has already been in contact with you. We are working with the Genesee County Health Department who may also contact you if your child has been identified as a close contact to a positive case.

We are taking measures to protect the wellbeing of the GCS students, including disinfecting the school building. Please continue to monitor for onset of symptoms related to COVID-19, including fever or chills, cough, sore throat, difficulty breathing, diarrhea, vomiting or abdominal pain, new onset severe headache, or new fatigue. If you note any change in the health of your child, please keep your child home from school and call your regular medical provider if you have additional concerns.
