GCS will be adding a varsity cross country team in the fall. This is competition in its purest form. If you run faster, you win. Keep your ears open for more information.

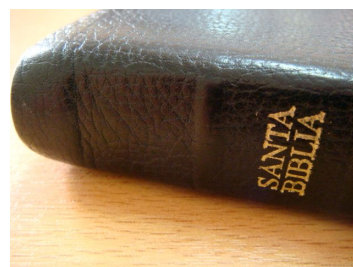
GCS Fun Run
